

## **2013 OurStage Intel® “Superstars” Competition Rules**

**NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.** OPEN ONLY TO OURSTAGE ACCOUNT-HOLDERS WHO ARE EIGHTEEN 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY AND ARE RESIDENTS OF THE 50 UNITED STATES OR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

- 1. INTEL “SUPERSTARS” COMPETITION OVERVIEW:** The Intel “Superstars” Competition will begin on August 15, 2013 and end on December 20, 2013. Round 1 of the Intel “Superstars” Competition, beginning on August 15, 2013 and ending on October 7, 2013 will consist of four genres (Rock, Pop, Latin, and R&B). Round 2 of the “Superstars” Competition, beginning on October 7, 2013 and ending November 30, 2013 will also consist of four genres (Country, Singer-Songwriter, Hip-Hop & Rap, and Electronic). In Round 3, the Top 20 ranked artists from each genre will automatically be entered to compete against each other to determine the Final 20. In Round 4, a judging panel of industry experts will evaluate the Final 20 and select a Grand Prize Winner.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY:** Open to OurStage account-holders who have Internet access, are residents of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia, and are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry. The following are not eligible: employees, contractors, directors and officers of Sponsor organizations, and each of their respective parent, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, distributors, web design, advertising, fulfillment, judging and Competition agencies involved in the administration, development, fulfillment and execution of this Competition (collectively, "Competition Parties"), and the immediate family members of each (spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent, and spouse or "step" of each) and those living in their same households (those persons whether related or not who live in the same residence for at least three months during the twelve-month period preceding the start date of the Competition).
- 3. COMPETITION PERIOD:** Competition for Round 1 begins at noon Eastern Time ("ET") on August 15, 2013 and ends at 11:59:59 am ET on October 7, 2013. Competition for Round 2 begins at noon ET on October 7, 2013 and ends at 11:59:59 am ET on November 30, 2013. ("Competition Period"). Competition for Round 3 begins at noon ET on November 30, 2013 and ends at 11:59:59 am ET on December 15, 2013.

**TO ENTER:** One unique Entry in each “Superstars” channel per person/OurStage account. Entrants may not enter the same song in more than one channel. To enter Competition, Entrant must first create a free account by logging on to OurStage’s Website, [www.ourstage.com](http://www.ourstage.com) ("Website"). Entrant must then upload an audio recording of Entrant or Entrant’s band performing their own original musical composition (“Submission Materials” or “Entry”) between noon ET on August 1, 2013 and 11:59:59 am ET on October 2, 2013 for Round 1, and between noon ET on September 22, 2013 and 11:59:59 am ET on November 26, 2013 for Round 2 (“Submission Period”). In order to be considered a valid Entry, the Submission Materials must conform to the criteria listed in Section 6 below. For the avoidance of doubt, Entrant, additional band members, and any individuals appearing in the Submission Materials must be at least the eligibility age listed in Section 2 above. However, for purposes of this Competition, the

official Entrant shall be deemed such individual who has registered the OurStage account associated with a given entry.

BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, ENTRANT ACKNOWLEDGES THAT HIS/HER ENTRY MAY BE POSTED ON SPONSORS' WEBSITES, AT SPONSORS' DISCRETION. Sponsors reserve the right to, and may or may not, monitor/screen entries prior to posting them to the Website. By entering, you acknowledge that Sponsors have no obligation to use or post any Entry you submit. Submission of an Entry grants Sponsor and its agents an unlimited, worldwide, perpetual, license and right to publish, use, publicly perform the Entry in any way, in any and all media, without limitation, and without consideration to the entrant. Please note: An artist may submit only one unique track into each of the Intel "Superstars" Competition Channels. If an artist submits the same song into multiple "Superstars" Channels, OurStage will remove the song from the genres deemed inappropriate. Sponsors may ban any entrant from competition at their discretion.

COMPETITION TERMS OF SUBMISSION:** As conditions of entry into a Competition, and by uploading an Entry, each Entrant warrants and represents that uploaded Entry (a) is your original work, (b) has not been previously published, (c) you are not under contract with a record company (d) does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity; (e) that you have obtained permission from any person whose name, likeness, or voice is used in the Entry; and (f) that publication of the Entry via various media including Web posting, will not infringe on the rights of any third party rights. **Technical Requirements**

The length of a music Entry must be greater than 30 seconds and no more than 15 minutes in length, and must be submitted in one of the formats allowed on the Upload/Compete page on the Website.

- Entrants must be **legal residents** of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia
- The Entry must be acceptable for radio airplay with **clean lyrics** sung in English
- Accepted genres for the **Rock “Superstars” Competition:** Alternative Rock, Funk, Indie Rock, Modern Rock, Rock, Soft Rock, Southern Rock
- Accepted genres for the **Pop “Superstars” Competition:** Pop and Indie Pop
- Accepted genres for the **Latin “Superstars” Competition:** Latin
- Accepted genres for the **R&B “Superstars” Competition:** R&B
- Accepted genres for the **Country “Superstars” Competition:** Country Channels including, Alternative Country, Country, Traditional Country
- Accepted genres for the **Singer-Songwriter “Superstars” Competition:** Singer-Songwriter must fall into the following genre based categories on OurStage: Singer-Songwriter
- Accepted genres for the **Hip-Hop & Rap “Superstars” Competition:** Hip-Hop, Rap, Alternative Hip-Hop
- Accepted genres for the **Electronic “Superstars” Competition:** House, Dubstep, Techno, Ambient/Chill/Downtempo, Electro

- No Entries will be returned. Competition Parties may, in their sole discretion, remove, delete and/or disqualify Entries deemed to be inappropriate or otherwise non-compliant

7. **SELECTION OF WINNERS:** Submission Materials received from valid Entrants during the Submission Period will be posted on [www.ourstage.com](http://www.ourstage.com) in the Intel “Superstars” channels and will compete against each other for the Competition prizes and Grand Prize (as defined below). These Submission Materials will be judged by OurStage members. There are four (4) rounds of judging for the Intel “Superstars” Competition. The outcome of the each round is based on judging by OurStage members, and may not result in the awarding of any prize.

Round 1 – Regular Judging: Round 1 of the Intel “Superstars” Competition will begin at noon ET on August 15, 2013 and end at 11:59:59 am ET on October 7, 2013. Members of OurStage will have the opportunity to judge Entries compared to other Entries. Automated methods of voting are strictly prohibited. The Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries in **each** Intel “Superstars” Competition channel (Rock, Pop, Latin, R&B) will be determined based on Round 1 judging using proprietary ranking algorithms. *For the avoidance of doubt, the Entrants that place first in the Intel “Superstars” Competition channels at the conclusion of Round 1 are NOT necessarily the Competition’s Grand Prize Winner.* The Top

Twenty (20) ranked Entries from each channel in Round 1 will automatically be entered into Round 3.

Round 2 – Regular Judging: Round 2 of the Intel “Superstars” Competition will begin at noon ET on October 7, 2013 and ends at 11:59:59 am ET on November 30, 2013. Members of OurStage will have the opportunity to judge Entries compared to other Entries. Automated methods of voting are strictly prohibited. The Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries in **each** Intel “Superstars” Competition channel (Country, Singer-Songwriter, Hip-Hop & Rap, Electronic) will be determined based on Round 2 judging using proprietary ranking algorithms. *For the avoidance of doubt, the Entrants that place first in the Intel “Superstars” Competition channels at the conclusion of Round 2 are NOT necessarily the Competition’s Grand Prize Winner.* The Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries from each channel in Round 2 will automatically be entered into Round 3.

Round 3 – Semi-Finals Judging: Round 3 of the Intel “Superstars” Competition begins at noon ET on November 30, 2013 and ends at 11:59:59 am ET on December 15, 2013. During Round 3, OurStage Members will have the opportunity to judge the Top One Hundred and Sixty (160) ranked Entries from across the eight competition channels to determine the Top Twenty (20) Entries. Automated methods of voting are strictly prohibited. At the end of Round 3, the Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries will progress to the Intel “Superstars” Finals Judging Panel.

Round 4 - Final Judging Panel: Round 4 of the Intel “Superstars” Competition begins on December 15, 2013 and ends on December 20, 2013. The Judging Panel will judge the Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries in the Intel “Superstars” Semi-Finals Round. Entries will be evaluated by a panel of judges. The judges will evaluate the Entries based on the following five (5) criteria: (i) presentation; (ii) originality and creativity; (iii) melody, vocal ability and music; (iv) lyrics; and (v) entertainment value. In the event of a tie, the Entrants may be re-judged based on any of the above criteria. The Entrant whose Entry receives the highest score among all judging criteria will be selected as the Grand Prize Winner, subject to verification. **For the avoidance of doubt, the panel of judges will decide the winner at their sole discretion, from among the Top Twenty (20) ranked Entries.** The decisions of the judging panels are final and binding on all matters relating to the Competition.

Entrants agree that the Sponsors have the sole right to decide all matters and disputes arising from this Competition and that all decisions of Sponsors are final and binding. Any attempt by Entrant and/or his/her family/friends to vote more than the number of times authorized using multiple names or email address and/or any other fraudulent mechanism, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, shall give Sponsors the right to disqualify entrant in its reasonable discretion.

Potential Grand Prize Winner and First Place Finalists will be notified by e-mail or phone and will be given instructions on how to claim prize.     - **They will include an Intel® Ultrabook™, Blue Microphones microphone, Creative Labs speaker, Gibson Brands Inc, electric guitar with case\*, HMDX Bluetooth wireless speaker, Orange amplifier, Sonos wireless speaker, and a V-MODA metal headphone.**
- \*NOTE: The electronic winner will not receive the Gibson Brand Inc. electric guitar, but will receive the Gibson Brands Inc. Stanton USB Mixstation.
- Total Estimated Retail Value for all prizes = \$50,000

### **Prize Distribution**

Prizes for the Intel "Superstars" Competition will be awarded no later than **January 31, 2014.**
